

Terms of Reference for The Migration and Development Unit

1. Formulate, implement, monitor and evaluate the national migration and development policy, legal and institutional framework.
 2. Facilitate the mainstreaming of migration policy and practice in Zimbabwe's national and sectoral development plans, for example;
 - i. Zimbabwe Economic Development Strategy
 - ii. National Budgets
 - iii. Youth Policies
 - iv. Poverty Assessment Study Survey III
 - v. Millennium Development Goals
 - vi. National censuses and surveys
 3. Identify and commission research on migration and development.
 4. Identify and engage Diasporas for investment and development initiatives in Zimbabwe;
 5. Formalize and harness the positive impact of labour migration for national socio-economic development, including leveraging and maximizing the developmental potential of remittances;
 6. Ensure the enforcement of measures to protect and promote the human rights and well-being of migrants;
 7. Strengthen technical cooperation in cross border labour management;
 9. Identify and initiate skills retention programmes and measures that mitigate the brain drain;
 10. Identify and initiate economic and community development for migration programmes to address the root causes of economically induced migration and provide livelihood alternatives for potential migrants.
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
